Oftentimes, when families get help communicating and understanding thoughts, feelings, and needs, there is a decrease in conflict and an increase in positive interactions and coping strategies. We will help your family build those skills.

CREATING A POSITIVE SUPPORT SYSTEM

Together, as a team comprised of family members, trusted supports and service providers, we will work together to have a positive impact on how the youth copes and functions.

We will reach out to school personnel, therapists, physicians, prescribers, extended family, etc. to help bring a positive outcome and goals that the youth and family choose.



UNDERSTANDING THE NEEDS

Our services are designed to help youth and their families who are struggling with behaviors and/or symptoms of mental illness and substance use disorder; and may be at risk of inpatient hospitalization or out-of-home placement.

SETTING GOALS

We help youth and their families better understand their needs, utilize their strengths, gain needed skills, and bring about greater overall adjustment in order to avoid unnecessary hospitalizations and out-of-home placements.
