Who we are: At the Essex County Probation Department our goal is to effect positive change in juvenile offenders placed on probation and diversion services by holding them accountable and facilitating their rehabilitation through collaborative approach with other service and treatment providers, while simultaneously promoting public safety.

What we do: At Essex County Probation, we have two juvenile probation officers that supervise youth in Essex County that may have been charged with a crime, or placed on the PINS program. Specifically, through our PINS program we are able to work collaboratively with schools, parents, and service providers to offer solutions to behaviors that include substance use, truancy, runaway and incorrigible behaviors.

What services we provide: PINS - Persons In Need of Supervision

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Is a referral needed? Yes - A referral form to place a youth on the PINS/Pre-PINS program will need to be filled out by the individual responsible for filing the complaint and will be identified as the "Petitioner."

Where the referral can be found: This form can be received by contacting a representative at the Probation Department, in person, by email or by phone. It is important to note that a PINS complaint, can lead to Family Court involvement.
