CHILDCARE

Advocates can provide prearranged childcare for clients during court proceedings or other essential appointments.



VICTIM COMPENSATION APPLICATIONS

As Victim Assistance Providers, advocates can assist clients in applying for compensation for essential personal property damaged as a result of domestic violence, through the New York State Office of Victim Services.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE ADVOCACY

Advocates can assist you with petitions in family court for Orders of Protection, accompany you to court hearings and proceedings, go to the police station while you file a report, and communicate on your behalf with the prosecutor.

Two New York State Office of Children and Family Services certified Safe Dwellings are available to provide, safe and confidential temporary housing while you locate permanent housing options or seek criminal justice interventions.
